Sample Problem Description

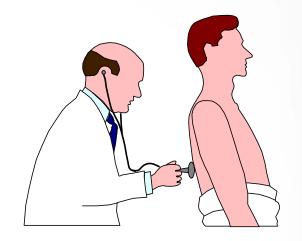

DMAIC



Step 1: Define

What is wrong?

What is expected from the team?

What is the planned schedule?



Step 2: Measure

What are the sources of data and information?

What data do we have?

What are the current processes?



Step 3: Analyze

FMEA

Cause and effect analysis

Data analysis



Step 4: Improve

Brainstorm for ideas to address causes of problems

Test ideas using reversed fishbone diagram and alternative scenarios

Conduct pilot experiment and analyze data to assess improvement



Step 5: Control

Set up control systems to hold gains

Design KPIs and a Dashboard to track budget planning processes

Evaluate effectiveness of improved process
